Dear Patient/Guarantor:

Your insurance company requires that we report our services to them using a coding system known as CPT (current procedural terminology). The CPT codes used to describe the surgery we did for you are found in the "surgery" section of the CPT workbook. This global period may be 10 or 90 days from you date of surgery. This is considered your "global period". This is the "normal" and/or "uncomplicated" follow up post operative care.

These services that are not included in the fee associated with the surgery are billed separately:

1. X-rays
2. All casting supplies (including those for first cast application)
3. Cast applications
4. Injections
5. Evaluation and Management for any additional problems or injuries
6. Treatment of complications
7. Complications resulting in a return to the operating room

There will be a separate charge for these and any appropriate co-payments, deductibles and coinsurance may apply. These will be required at time of service.

Note: Cast replacements that are not for medical necessity may be denied by your insurance company and may be billed to you directly.
